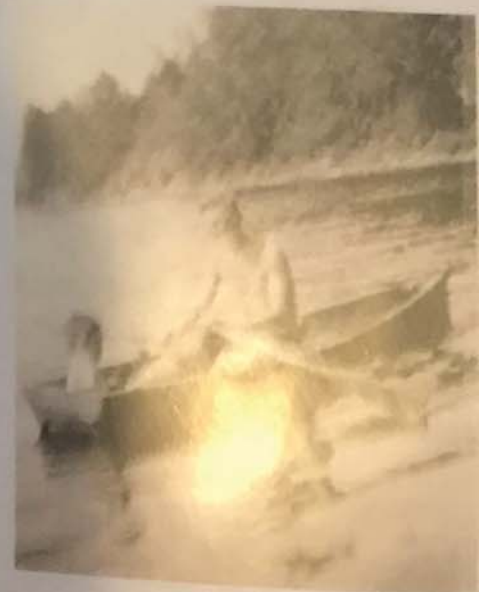
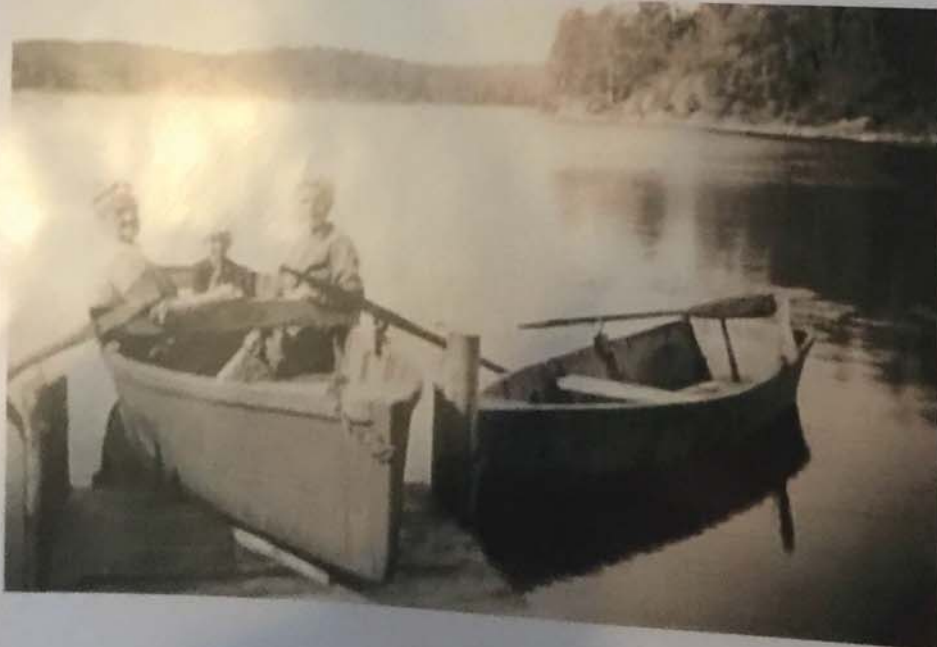

Before the road was built everything came by water or horse and wagon if the road through the swamp was frozen

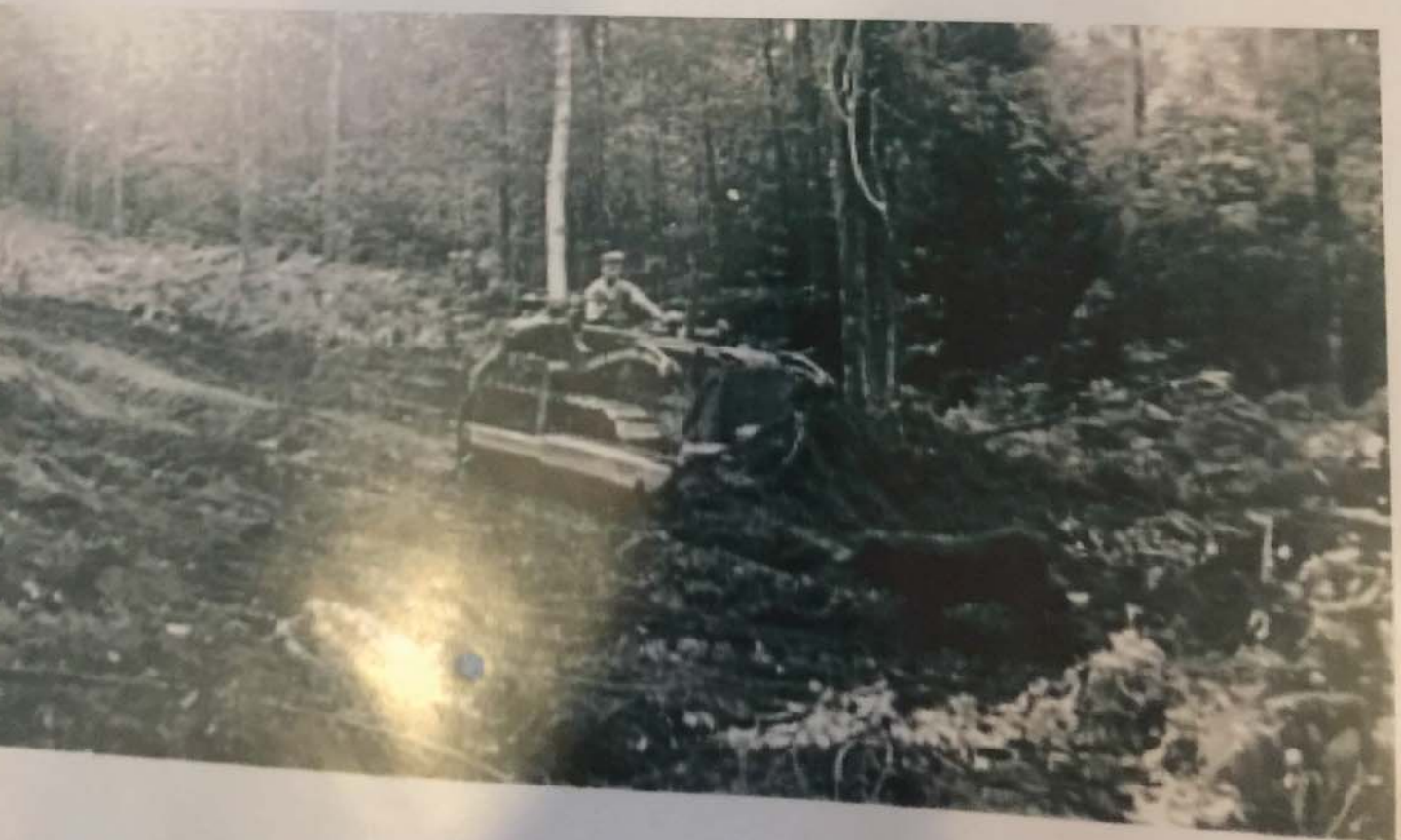
