It was moved by R. Hughes and seconded by P. Wilson that a letter be drafted issuing privileges of the Cascades Club grounds to the Cascades Youth Welfare Association. The agreement being:

1. Renewable on yearly basis
2. Daylight hours at the discretion of the Cascades Club Inc.

Inventory of Assets:

1. A. Hopkins and J. Grant will take an inventory of assets belonging to the club.
2. L. Pilon stated that 6 or 7 arborite tables belong to him plus the B.B.Q. (N. Grant) also a share in B.B.Q.
3. The Treasurer will be in charge of assets belonging to the club - e.g. anyone wishing to borrow tables, or benches must contact the Treasurer.
4. It was suggested that we look into the possibilities of purchasing a record player - also a cabinet be built for security.

A letter was sent to J. Grant as follows:

It was moved by R. Hughes and seconded by L. Pilon that a General Meeting - Election of new officers followed by a social evening. The meeting will be held on Friday, May 9th at 8:30 p.m.
