

General Meeting of the Cascades Club Inc. Nov 19th
1977 2 P.M.

Purpose of the meeting was to establish relationship between the Cascades Club Inc. and the Squash Subscribers by way of additional bylaws

Executive Present: Al Hopkins President, Norm Grant Vice-President, Secretary Helva Gibson, Treasurer Elaine Spallin; Executive Committee, Bob and Judy Ross, Jan and Carol Stewart and Preston Wilson.

The President gave a brief history of the squash proposal and explained the purpose of this meeting.

The Secretary read the minutes of the Annual General Meeting of Aug. 26th 1977. They were accepted as read on a motion by John Partington seconded by Pat MacGowan.

The proposed additional bylaws were read to the meeting by Preston Gibson.

A lengthy discussion followed with the following concerns being expressed:

1. Liability of Cascades Club if the squash venture floundered.
2. Adequacy of the well to provide for the additional facilities.
3. Cost of squash memberships.

4. Effect of a squash facility being built in Stakefield.
5. Allocation of insurance premiums.
6. Exclusiveness of squash facility.
7. Influx of non-community members.
8. Rapidity of development of squash idea.
9. Changes in the character of the club.

Most of these concerns were remedied by detailed explanation of the bylaws and the reaffirmation that the squash subscribers would work towards the improvement of the Cascades Club as a whole and try to enlarge its role in the community.

The treasurer of the squash subscribers read their financial statement. It was explained that the completion of the squash project is personally guaranteed by its members signing a Registrar which commits them to advance additional funds if required.

It was moved by Pit Geynesowski, seconded by Keith Saunders that the squash subscribers be responsible for all additional insurance arising from the squash facility and the

ancillary facilities.

Mrs Mignot volunteered to assist in 1978 Cascades Club membership drive. Mrs Lauder volunteered to ascertain the needs of the children in the community that could be met by the Cascades Club.

Paul Martin moved, seconded by Leigh Grant that the vote on the motion of bylaws establishing relationship between the Cascades Club Inc. & Squash membership be held. Ron Grant acted as Recording Officer. A show of hands was recorded along with one proxy vote. The results were: Fifty-six in favor
Four opposed.

The "opposed" and the "in favor" groups offered mutual congratulations on well presented viewpoints.

It was moved by Keith Saunders, seconded by Pat Mac Gowan the meeting be adjourned.
