Alan Hopkins has talked to a lawer-as-well-as lawyer who advises yhat before a liquor licence may be obtained certain specific requirements must be met, of which Al has the list. A plan must be available showing the kitchen the toilet facilities, the way doors open, etc. Photos of the building, a copy of the constitution, and a copy of the deed. One individual from the club must exept responsibilities for the licence. Cost varies. Usually 50.00 are required by the liquor board, an initial fee of 100.00 by the lawyer as well as another 100;00 dollars later, and the anual licence costs 100.00. Bob Williams moved that we approve the release of an initial 150.00 and further funds as and when necessary. Gail Weynerowski seconded themotion. Carried. Also required will be a letter from the mayor announcing that the club is not in a " dry " community.
