

CASCADES CLUB MEETING

April 14/83

The April 14/83 meeting of the Cascades Club Inc. was attended by M. McLeod M. McAllindor, P. Forget, S. Allen, R. Ross, W. Lavallee, J. Krauenburg and P. Wilson. M. Wilson attended as a guest.

Minutes of the last meeting (March 10/83) were approved by S. Allen and seconded by P. Forget, with the following alteration: Wilf Lavallee was granted, by a unanimous vote a complimentary individual squash membership and a family social membership until May 31, 1984.

The Club is to spend \$100.00 on prizes for the upcoming club squash championships. Moved by M. McAllindon. Seconded by W. Lavallee. M. McAllindon to check with Molsons re trophies.

Lack of squash activity and the decline in number of annual squash members (25 in 81-82, vs 17 in 82-83) was discussed. Many good promotional ideas were presented by P. Forget and M. McAllindon.

P. Wilson moved that that annual squash membership be changed to Sept. 1 to Sept 1, to coincide with the squash season. Seconded by M. McAllindon. The 'social' year (May 1 to May 1) will remain unchanged.

Cleaning of the premises was again discussed exhaustively, with many ideas evaluated. Finally a motion by S. Allen, seconded by P. Forget was unanimously accepted. The motion is that all life members be assessed a \$25.00 cleaning deposit refundable upon the completion of cleaning duties.

The application for membership by David Morrison was reviewed. He will, upon the promise to deliver two loads of material when we repair our driveway, and upon payment of current membership dues be reinstated.

P. Forget moved that Summer Squash Membership (May 1 to Sept 1) be offered at \$50.00 individual and \$75.00 family. No social membership or initiation charges will be required. Seconded by M. MacLeod.

Mr. Quince showed interest in using the Club for square dance lessons. R. Ross to obtain more details.

At 7:30 P.M. on May 7, following the finals in the squash championship and the A.G.M., a 'Pub Nite' of curry (by Robin & Ina Wilson) and an evening of 'TRIVIAL PURSUIT' will be held. Admission to the meal will be \$4.00 per person.
