GENERAL SQUASH IDEAS: B. Ripley produced an excellent "program" which it was decided would be included with newsletter/membership receipt form (with combination noted) and one free guest pass to ALL club members - hoping to attract additional squash players! To be added to program: new squash fees, mention of ladder. (M. Hill) Bob will follow-up on "School program" with W. Allan (High School) and Sandy Welburn (Wakefield School). M. Williams suggested Junior after-school program - can be explored later, once main programs have been implemented.

Looking forward to May 85 City Invitational - details to be provided later.
League: hoping to attract more players from Club - Ladies' entry to be looked into!
Ladder: Murray will be posting signs at club shortly, with details.
Roster sheets: supply to be provided by G. Hill.
Melva will supply Bob with Club membership lists for past 2-3 years, denoting status of members, etc., for study.

Several suggestions were made as application was not permitted to cover building/premises. Also only 25% of application would be received, as use by general public restricted to ball field. M. Hill suggested that a playground area should be considered, as small children are without any safe, flat area. Keith will explore all suggestions made.

Roof - Keith will follow-up with Bob Crawford re leak over stereo/leak on Court 2.

Alarm - book not yet available (Keith to contact Jim later tonight)

Suggestions: M. Williams suggested possibility of outside lights being tripped when alarm goes - Keith to investigate.

INSURANCE: Maggi verified additional \$30 on premium provides Club with unstipulated coverage for damages incurred while persons trying to burglarize; however, actual items stolen will NOT be covered.

ANNUAL BEEF BBQ: Melva reported NET profit approx. \$600, with \$100 meat credit to be utilised for social events (stored in Ross freezer). Donated dishwasher (N.Grants) arrived in time for BBQ, and cleaning now reduced approx. 50%.

To avoid misunderstandings, it was suggested that teenagers interested in clean-ups be advised beforehand that payment would depend on volume of work - unable to estimate accurately, as members insisted on cleaning before leaving club this time!

It was decided to pay \$25, as cleaning time was limited to 1½ hours each teenager; it was also pointed out that many other juniors had worked free on Saturday - salads, tables, wrapping spuds, and selling "pop".

M.Hill mentioned that Club cleaning should be done weekly, as courts will be used more. M. Wilson will advise cleaning lady, and Leigh-Anne will take over payment (liaison with Murray for funds monthly)

CONSTRUCTION: N. Grant injured back, so unable to complete stone wall. Keith has men lined up for this weekend. Keith was authorised to proceed with purchase of new club doors, liason with Treasurer essential! Also, Keith to follow-up on prices for Squash entry doors.
