

CASCADES CLUB MINUTES

JULY 11, 1988

1. The regular monthly meeting of the Cascades Club Executive was held on July 11, 1988 at 8:00 PM. Present were:
  - Cathy Crawford, Pres.
  - Murray McAllindon, Treas.
  - Doug Taylor, V. Pres.
  - Chris Holloway, Membership
  - Chris Beasley, Secy.
2. Cathy Crawford noted two corrections to the minutes from the June 7th meeting: (item 3) a spelling correction to Darla Drader's name, and (item 11) the price of beef is \$2.69/lb. The minutes were then accepted by those present.
3. The annual Beef BBQ that took place on June 18th was discussed. The club made approximately \$400 profit. There were approximately 70 adults and 36 children present. There are two cooked roasts and one uncooked roast left over from the BBQ.
4. The club charter is to be reviewed by Murray McAllindon, after obtaining it from Chris Holloway, to look into the possibility of turning the club into an official non-profit organization. If and when the club is registered as such, Micheline Leduc will look into obtaining grants.
5. Donations to the club, pledged by members during the May 6th AGM, were discussed. The pledges were: (1) Bob Crawford offered to donate a new roof; and (2) Bob Hughes offered to install the trim on the exterior windows. Cathy Crawford said she would have Roy Ball follow up on these pledges, and also ask him to canvass local businesses for donations.
6. The issue of renting the club facility to the public (with no member as sponsor) was discussed at length. It was decided that the club will be available for rental to the public on the following terms:
  - (a) One responsible person signs a form showing pertinent information, and taking responsibility for damages and clean-up.
  - (b) A rental fee of \$30 will be charged.
  - (c) A deposit of \$50 will be charged, and returned if no damages occur or no extra clean-up is required.
  - (d) If a bartender is required, those renting the club must find a club member to serve as bartender. If they cannot do so, the club will provide a bartender at an extra charge of \$5.00/hr.
7. The club was invited to participate in the upcoming West Hull Festival (August 27 & 28). It was decided to offer to host a squash tournament, and to offer to set up a booth with lemonade and baked goods at the site in Old Chelsea. Cathy Crawford offered to be responsible for the lemonade; Chris Beasley offered to phone members for baked goods; Doug Taylor offered



to look into setting up the booth; and Chris Holloway offered to provide a club sign, and be responsible for recruiting new members during the festival. Cathy Crawford is to phone Francois Lemay, then get back to the Executive.

8. The Karate Club fee adjustment for August through October was discussed at length. It was decided to charge a total of \$225, with another adjustment in November (for heating).
9. Cathy Crawford informed the Executive that Diane Renaud had borrowed three tables and some benches, and will return them on July 17th.
10. The rental of the club on July 22nd by the Municipality of West Hull for the Arctic Expedition Appreciation Night was discussed. Judy Grant is the club member responsible, and will sign a waiver for any damages that may occur. Chris Beasley is to draw up a form stating that no staples are to be used on the walls or ceiling, and all thumbtacks, tape, etc., must be removed; and that the club's bar facilities are to be used. Cathy Crawford is to notify Bob Flood that the bar will need to be stocked.
11. The issue of a levy to members was briefly discussed. Doug Taylor pointed out that when it was brought up and discussed at the last AGM, it was virtually dropped as a means of raising money. It was decided not to pursue this item.
12. The annual membership fee increase was arrived at after lengthy discussion. A motion was made by Murray McAllindon to set the initiation fee at 25% of the squash fee, for both family and individual squash members. The motion was accepted by all present. The following shows the current (1987-88) fee structure, and the new (1988-89) fees:
