Cascades Club Minutes May 16, 1989

- 1. The regular meeting of the Cascades Club took place on May 16, 1989 at 8:00 P.M. Present were Chris Holloway, Pres.; Chris Beasley, Secy; Jean Seguin, Bldg & Grounds.
- 2. The Recreation Dept of West Hull, on Wed., May 31, plans a "Participaction Day" from 5PM to 10PM with twin city of Edson, Alberta. - 3. There will be an extra Executive on meeting Tues, May 30, to discuss the Beef BBQ. The date is Sat., June 10, and it will be an all you can eat beef and chicken bbq. Events to take place:
 - (1) Build steps up to main front door. Ron Grant is donating 15 railroad ties. Jean to look into prices of stone dust for next meeting. Chris H. to call Bernie as well. Will follow Phase I of Keith Saunders' plan, which is steps leading to main entrance (to foyer). Jean Seguin to organize work crew.
 - (2) Menu for the day is: Salad, Beef, Chicken, Potatoes, Rolls & Dessert. Discussion followed about things to do for the BBQ. This will be covered in more detail when all the members of the Executive meet on May 30 (see below).

- 6. Grass cutting was discussed. It is a problem for Jean Seguin because he has hay fever. Jean suggested buying a lawn mower and having a rotation list of people to volunteer to cut the grass (once every two weeks).
