in the Province of Lower Canada, for the good  
will we bear unto Thomas Wright, issue of the  
Marriage between the said Mary & the said Thomas  
Wright deceased and for and in consideration of the  
Sum of five Shillings current money of the said  
Province to us in hand paid by the said Thomas  
Wright, at & before the sealing & delivery of these  
presents, have and each of us doth hereby sell  
assign & set over unto the said Thomas Wright  
for himself his brothers & sisters from this day  
henceforth and for ever, all our right, title, interest,  
property, claim and demand whatsoever, of in  
and to any quantity of land, gifted and allowed  
by the Government of the said Province of  
Lower Canada, unto the said Mary Wright  
Whilst the wife of the said Thomas Wright  
deceased, in the Township of Templeton, on the  
Grand or Ottawa river in the said District of  
Montreal be the same more or less, without  
any reserve whatsoever, to be by him the said  
Thomas Wright held in trust to the use of  
himself and others his brothers & sisters, born of  
the said marriage, & to be divided between them  
Share & Share alike, to his & their sole use benefit

and behoof to be by them the said Thomas Wright, his brothers & sisters as aforesaid, and his and their respective heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, possessed and enjoyed in full property from this day henceforth and forever by virtue of these presents, And we the said John and Mary do hereby further covenant, promise Oblige and agree that we shall and will at all times hereafter, do and execute all and all other acts and deeds necessary for the further and more absolutely confirming the said land at present sold and intended to be sold when thereunto required by the said Thomas Wright or so soon after the Patent or Grant shall have issued for the said Township of Templeton (provided always that we shall not be put to or at the costs & charges of said deeds) on pain of all costs charges damages and interest.

In Witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals at Hull aforesaid the twenty fourth day of August in the year of Our Lord One thousand Eight hundred & five, in the presence of the subscribing witnesses to be hereafter deposited in the office of a Notary Public at the diligence and request of the said Thomas Wright
